Introduction

Dr. Livingstone has served as the first woman dean of Pepperdine University's Graziadio School since June 2002. During her tenure, she oversaw a \$200 million expansion of the business school's regional campuses and the opening of the 50-acre Drescher Graduate Campus in Malibu, Calif. Under her leadership, the business school established the Education to Business (E2B) Applied Learning Program, which provides students with real-world experience consulting for small- and medium-sized companies and major corporations, and launched the Dean's Executive Leadership Series, a high-profile lecture program that introduces students and alumni to leading business innovators.

Experience

Dr. Livingstone is a professor of management with a research focus that includes creativity in organizations as influenced by the fit between the individual and the organizational environment. Prior to joining the Graziadio School in 2002, Dr. Livingstone was the associate dean for graduate programs at the Hankamer School of Business at Baylor University where she was responsible for the oversight of 11 full-time graduate degree programs.

Dr. Livingstone received her B.S., M.B.A., and Ph.D. from Oklahoma State University.
